Loss Prevention Measures - Oil Cargo from Piracy

Piracy has made a comeback in our waters. This topic presents a mariner's account of what the pirates are after, how they operate and what can be done to mitigate the risk.

Risk Engineering of Project Cargo – An Underwriter's Perspective

This topic presents an underwriter's perspective on Risk Engineering of Project Cargo including Delay in Start-up (DSU). Among the areas covered are what a project is, underwriting consideration for a project cargo and how to manage cargo exposure, the importance of a warranty survey, DSU coverage and how Risk Engineering helps to improve the quality of a project cargo risk including DSU cover.

Palm Oil Risk Control and Management

This topic puts forward a basic risk management model for the carriage of palm oil, how the concept of risk management is applied to the assessment and control of risks that have historically been found to apply to the carriage of palm oil as well as the various risks affecting the quality and quantity of outturn together with applicable control measures.
